

- Learning coaches available for assistance in class





HOW TO ENROL

STEP 1:

STEP 2:

Submit your completed application form along with all supporting documents (indicated on the application form) via email: info.jewelcity@curro.co.za
Note: Supporting documents for online enrolments are to be uploaded.

STEP 3:

Application forms will be assessed.

STEP 4:

If successful, parents will receive via email, a welcome letter and invoice for a once-off non-refundable enrolment fee.

STEP 5:

Once the enrolment fee is paid, the child's place is confirmed (please retain proof of payment for record purposes).

STEP 6:

Please refer to www.curro.co.za regularly to stay up to date with all the relevant news and arrangements.


Learners are prepared for the National Senior Certificate (NSC) examination at the end of Grade 12.

Learners have access to:


- a coding and Robotics programme;
