DEBIT-ORDER COMPLETION

Debit orders substantially reduce the administrative burden when identifying deposits into our bank account and allocating them to the correct learner accounts. We rely on predictable monthly cash flows to pay teachers' salaries and to manage our operations, and trust that you will keep your accounts up to date.

GENERAL

1. School fees

School fees for 2026 exclude the following:

- Textbooks, workbooks and stationery (including e-books) – certain textbooks for Grade R to Grade 7 will be invoiced on statement.
- Entrance fees, travel costs, accommodation and food for non-academic school excursions and sports trips, unless otherwise advised by the school (when making payment, please use the reference number (WAT-_____) or (100_____) as per school fee statement). Please note: learners may not attend tours or outings if fees are not paid up to date.
- The e-learning device for Grades 4 to 7 and any insurance, maintenance or other costs relating to the device.
- School uniforms
- Therapists' and psychologists' fees

2. Aftercare

- The aftercare fees are invoiced to the school fee account.
- A meal and a snack are included.
- Supervised limited homework support will take place every school-day afternoon (foundation phase from 14:00 – 15:00 and intersen phase from 15:00 – 16:00).
- These classes exclude specialised subject and specialised homework support.

- Learners provide their own stationery for homework.
- Aftercare is signed up for a term at a time, a term being three months as per the school calendar.
- Any cancellation requires **a full calendar month's written notice** before the end of a term.
- The holidays referred to are school holidays.
- The aftercare is not open on public holidays and closes from 11 December 2025.
- There are no additional levies, although some optional activities during the holidays may carry a charge.
- Holiday care has no charge for learners attending aftercare during the term (this excludes half-day and day visitors).

3. Savings

Savings are applicable only to the tuition portion of the fees.

- **Annual saving:** 5% granted on a 12-month advance payment.
- **Family saving:** A 5% saving will be granted on the annual and monthly school fees of the younger siblings.
- **Bursary:** Awarded bursaries are deducted only on the tuition fee portion and after all other savings.

4. Termination of enrolment

Parents/Guardians may terminate the admission and enrolment of a learner after the commencement of the first day of the school year by providing the school with at **least 3 (three) calendar months'** written notice of termination.
