GENERAL

1. School fees

School fees for 2024 exclude the following:

- School uniforms
- Stationery
- Entrance fees, travel costs, accommodation and food for school excursions and sports trips, unless otherwise advised by the school
- School photos
- Therapists' and psychologists' fees
- Selected workbooks and textbooks

2. Aftercare fees (Grade R to Grade 7 only)

- The aftercare programme is fully revamped to include **homework assistance**, **structured activities** and supervised **free play**.
- Learners **not enrolled in the aftercare programme,** who are not collected after school **by 15:30,** will be directed to aftercare and parents will be billed accordingly at the day visitor rate.
- The aftercare programme includes a light snack/fruit including a juice. Lunch is not included in the fees; however, lunch can be arranged directly at the tuck shop or alternatively parents can pack lunch for their child/ren.
- The aftercare programme runs **daily after school, during the school term, from 15:00 to 17:30**, from the first day of term to the last day of term across all four terms in the year.
- High school learners are not eligible for aftercare, but rather attend extra classes arranged by the high school team.



3. E-learning devices (tablets)

• Grades 8 to 12 may use devices as a **supplement** to the curriculum. It is not compulsory, but it can enhance learning and allow learners to receive electronic learning supplements via Microsoft Teams. Devices are brought to school at own risk. Device specifications will be sent to parents by the end of 2023.

4. Textbooks

- Hard copies of textbooks will be used.
- Some books will be provided by the school and others will be purchased by the learners. Lists will be provided.
- Textbooks handed out by the school remain the property of Curro Academy Riverside. Learners need to cover the textbooks and take care to return them to the school in a good condition by the end of the academic year.
- Learners who return damaged books or if books are lost, will be billed the replacement cost of the book.
- Learners purchase their own workbooks. Lists will be provided.

5. Enhancement centre – Go Focus (Grades 1 to 9)

- To qualify to enter the enhancement programme, learners need to be referred by the teacher.
- The enhancement centre focuses on assisting learners with literacy gaps and English barriers and gross motor and fine motor skills development.
- There is no extra cost for the service, but learners must meet the criteria to make use of the service.
- Grades 4 to 9 have remedial/enhancement periods included in their timetable in order to improve English results.

6. Choice in first additional languages

- Grades 1 to 9 learners have a choice between FAL languages: Afrikaans FAL, isiZulu FAL or Setswana FAL.
- Grades 10 to 12 can choose between Afrikaans FAL and isiZulu FAL. Setswana is still phasing in.
